He or she also understands that the signature below is for both a medical and liability release.

I also agree to accept full financial responsibility for the cost of such treatment."

Youth Ministry Behavior Guidelines

1. When transportation is involved in any youth activity, all students ride the church designated vehicles. No student is allowed to drive.
2. Students are expected to comply with any and all instructions given by any adult youth staff members.
3. Students are to demonstrate respect for the Lord by demonstrating respect for church facilities and vehicles. Should a student's actions cause damage or breakage, he/she will be held responsible for repair or replacement of the broken or damaged item.
4. When attending church activities, all students are expected to participate in those activities, not hang around outside the church building, roam the hallways, etc.
5. When participating in any church activity, all students are expected to be present for the entirety of the event. Unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time between the youth minister and that student's parents, no student is allowed to join an event already in progress or leave one early.
6. When we return from an activity, we ask that parents pick up their students at the time stated. Because we try very hard both to accurately pinpoint our return times and to notify parents from the road on those rare occasions when we do experience major delays, we ask that parents be here to meet us when we arrive, rather than waiting at home for a phone call from their young person.
7. Upon our return from any road trip, students are expected to help clean out the interior of the church vehicle(s) before claiming their luggage and going home.
8. Because we want to maintain a positive, Christ-centered atmosphere at all of our youth ministry functions, we ask that students keep godliness and modesty in mind in their clothing choices. Specifically:
 - Guys are to wear shirts at all times (except when swimming).
 - Girls should avoid wearing extremely short skirts, low necklines, and/or other tight, revealing clothing. T-shirts must be worn beneath tops with spaghetti straps. Only modest one-piece swimsuits will be permitted.
 - Clothing worn to youth events should be free of ungodly images and messages.
9. Although MP3 Players and Handheld Game Systems will be permitted on youth trips, we ask students to exercise discretion in their choices of music, video games, etc., to bring along. Our youth leaders reserve the right to permanently confiscate music or video games that blatantly promote ungodliness.
10. This should go without saying, but for the record, alcohol, tobacco of any kind, illegal drugs, firearms, knives, pornography, foul language, coarse joking, public displays of affection between couples, and/or uncooperative attitudes will not be permitted to be a part of any Auburn Christian Church youth function.
11. The rule we are aiming for: ". . . whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father" (Colossians 3:17). If you can't do it in the name of Jesus, you probably don't need to do it at all.
12. The youth staff of Auburn Christian Church reserves the right to dismiss or suspend from any activity any student who demonstrates an attitude of indifference to God and to others by intentionally and remorselessly violating these guidelines. If the violation occurs during the course of an out-of-town event, dismissal may include sending the student home at his/her parents' expense.

We have read these guidelines. We agree to abide by them, and understand the consequences of not following them.
